#### COMMUNICATION

We will continue to communicate to you through LINC-ED this year. This is a one stop online environment that is secure, easy and effective. You will continue to have access to comments, learning goals, assessments, images and reports about your child.

Starting this year, we will be sending out one main communication every Friday afternoon outlining details of the week ahead. This will include whole school dates and information along with important information for each year level. It is important that you open the email attachment to see all the newsletter content and a copy of the notice will also be available on the school website. We hope that this will limit the number of school communications you receive.

#### STEPS TO LITERACY

Last year we introduced the Steps to Literacy online learning programme with great success in all of our Year 3 to 6 classes and would like to do the same in 2020.

While Steps looks like fun, it is a serious learning tool which develops all aspects of literacy, including vocabulary, comprehension and verbal reasoning.

Steps is based on the latest research into literacy acquisition and how the brain works. It is designed by literacy experts and shown to be highly effective.



To purchase this programme individually it would cost \$80, however, as are able to purchase a bulk licence we can offer this programme for just \$12 per child. Please visit the school shop to make your \$12 donation for this programme.

#### **SCHOOL UNIFORM**

#### **ANNUAL SCHOOL AGREEMENT FORMS**

To streamline our administration and be more environmentally friendly (by conserving paper usage) we have created an enrolment process that is online and records digitally the parent agreements for our <a href="Digital">Digital</a>

This year therefore instead of sending out the complete paper agreements to all our families who have enrolled before January 2020 we are sending out one paper form which will require you to indicate your acceptance to all the agreements. By accepting the different agreements you will be confirming you have read and understood the agreement contents as shown in both the digital links above. The information from the form will then be stored in LINC ED for the rest of your child's time at Gulf Harbour School.

These agreements are to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the students at our school. The information from the different agreements may be shared with and may be seen by the GHS staff. The data will be stored on your child's secure digital file on LINC ED for the duration of their time at our school. The information will only be taken off the data base at such time as the students account becomes inactive or a request from another school is made for information as part of an inter school transition request.

We will endeavour to remind all parents at the start of each year about these documents and advise you of any amendments to them if necessary. At any point you can request changes or withdraw your consent to the documents by submitting a written notice to <a href="mailto:office@ghs.school.nz">office@ghs.school.nz</a> or by dropping it into the front office. A letter containing the table below will be sent home with your child for you to complete, sign and return to school by **February 28th.**

We are encouraging our children to have less packaging in their lunchboxes this year. Any rubbish will be packed back into their boxes and brought home.



#### Here is the GHS donation structure for 2020:




